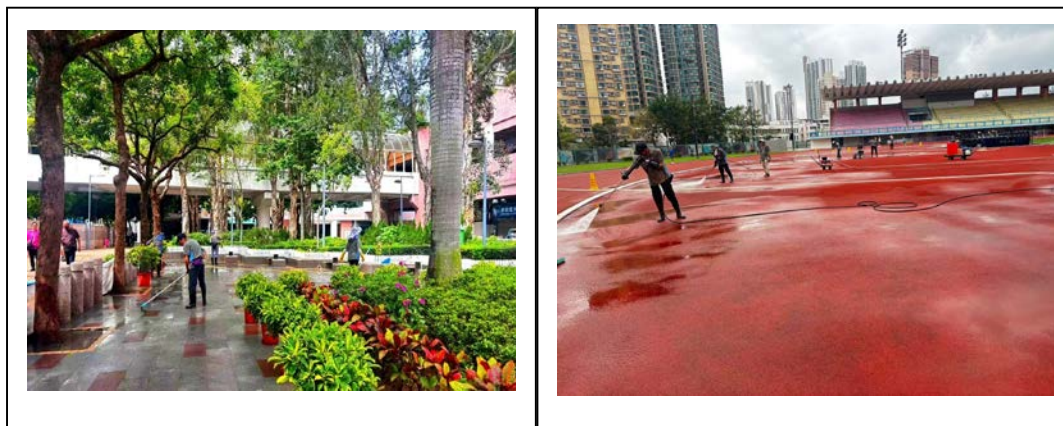

(30 April 2026 – Hong Kong) Beijing Enterprises Urban Resources Group Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "**Company**" or "**Group**"; stock code: 03718.HK) is pleased to announce that Shiny Glory Services Limited ("**Shiny Glory Services HK**"), an 85% owned subsidiary of the Company, has successfully won the bid recently for the five projects, the Provision of Cleaning and Supporting Services to Leisure Venues in Islands, Tsuen Wan, Tuen Mun, Yuen Long and Kwai Tsing Districts of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, through a tendering process (the "**Tenders**") by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China (the "**HK**").

Under the Tenders, the scope of services to be provided by Shiny Glory Services HK includes but not limited to the provision of cleansing, pest control, waste collection, recyclable waste collection services and other supporting services to leisure venues, parks and playgrounds of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department in Islands, Tsuen Wan, Tuen Mun, Yuen Long and Kwai Tsing Districts in HK. The contracts for the five projects are expected to commence on 1 May 2026 for a term of three years. The estimated annual revenue from these contracts is approximately HK\$321.51 million, with an estimated total contract value of approximately HK\$964.54 million.



Since the Group acquired an 85% equity interest in Shiny Glory Services HK in 2024, its operational performance has maintained a steady upward improvement. The total revenue of its HK business in 2025 increased by approximately 54% compared with that in 2024,

and the number of service projects expanded from 35 to 49 during the year. These favourable results have been attained with the strong support of the Group, enabling Shiny Glory Services HK to further enhance its tendering flexibility and broaden its project selection scope. Its business coverage has extended from traditional street cleansing services for the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department to diverse services for a number of government departments, including the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, the Hospital Authority and the HK Trade Development Council. Since the start of 2026, Shiny Glory Services HK has successfully secured a number of high-quality projects. In particular, it has been awarded contracts for the cleansing and maintenance of leisure facilities and parks across various districts in HK under the purview of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.

The successful awarding of the five projects in HK marks important progress in the Group's market expansion in the region, and fully demonstrates the recognition and trust of HK clients towards the Group. These new projects will enable the Group to further expand its local market share in HK, enhance brand awareness, and accumulate high-quality customer resources as well as overseas project experience. The Group will sustain a steady and sound development momentum and further consolidate its leading market position within the industry.

The Company wishes to state that the Group has yet to enter into any formal contract in relation to the Tenders. The actual total contract value and annual revenue may be different to this press release as a result of any unexpected changes in the market environment and other conditions. No forecast or prediction of the profits of the Group has been made with regard to the Tenders in this press release.
